**Walk-Ins:** Free weekly walk-in consultations designed for quick questions and orientation to career resources. No appointment necessary; 5- to 10-minute consultations on a first-come, first-served basis.

**One-on-One Appointments:** Appointments are available for a small fee. Recent alumni within six months of graduation may sign up for appointments free of charge.

**Career Assessments:** Alumni can take the Strong Interest Inventory® and Myers-Briggs Type Indicator® and have their results discussed with a trained counselor for a small fee. Recent alumni within six months of graduation may take them free of charge.

**Career Seminars and Events:** Designed for the experienced professional, career seminars and events cover a wide range of topics, presented by leaders in the career-counseling and coaching fields. These seminars are available to alumni for a small fee.
